September Highlight Event
12 Angry Men & Dinner at 388

The highlight event for September will be the drama **12 Angry Men**, at the **John Engeman Theater**. The John Engeman Theater, located in Northport, is one of the newest theaters on Long Island and uses an Actors Equity cast. The original 1957 film explores what begins as an open and shut case of murder but soon becomes a mini-drama of each of the juror's prejudices and preconceptions about the trial, the accused, and each other.

In 2007, **12 Angry Men** was selected for preservation in the United States National Film Registry.

Following the show, there will be dinner at **388 Restaurant** located on Willis Avenue, right here in Roslyn. This neat American Italian restaurant is attracting a following with the flair and flavor of its wide ranging menu, served up in plentiful portions by a friendly and attentive staff.

We have **30 orchestra seats** for the matinee performance on **Sunday, September 29th at 2PM**. The cost for **Dinner & Show is \$65 per person for residents and \$75 per person for non residents**.

October Highlight Event
The Rockefeller Estate (Kykuit)

Join the Senior Activities Committee on Thursday, October 10th, as we travel to the Rockefeller Estate (Kykuit). Kykuit is the preeminent Hudson Valley landmark. For architecture, remarkable gardens, art, history, and spectacular scenery, a trip to Kykuit is simply amazing. This hilltop paradise was home to four generations of the Rockefeller family, beginning with the philanthropist John D. Rockefeller, the founder of Standard Oil, in his day, the richest man in America.

Our tour will take us to the main rooms of the six-story stone house. We will then walk through the expansive, terraced gardens containing Governor Nelson A. Rockefeller's exceptional collection of 20th-century sculpture from artists such as Picasso. We will then continue to the underground art galleries to view Governor Rockefeller's collection of Picasso tapestries, and the cavernous Coach Barn, with its collections of classic automobiles and horse-drawn carriages.

After a break for lunch at Sunset Cove Restaurant with its views of the majestic Hudson, the Tappan Zee Bridge, and the soaring Palisades, we will continue our tour with a visit to the Union Church of Pocantico Hills. The church contains stained glass windows by Henri Matisse and Marc Chagall, commissioned by members of the Rockefeller family in the 1950s and 1960s.
