


### October Special Event—Brunch in the Park

Our Brunch program continues on **Sunday, October 27<sup>th</sup> at 11AM**. Join us for Brunch at the Theater in the Park. Our special guest speaker will be our own **William C. Burton, Esq., Village Attorney and Partner in Sagat|Burton, LLP**. Bill is a former New York State Assistant Attorney General, and a former New York State Assistant Special Prosecutor, Bill will provide us with an insider's view of ***The Life of a Lobbyist in Washington, D.C.*** and will discuss the techniques and difficulties of lobbying in our nation's capital, with


## November Special Event — Sponsored by the NY State Bar Association Elder Law and Health Care

## New York Historical Society The Armory Show at 100

Lauded as one of the most influential events in the history of American art, the **Armory Show** has a mythic legacy that rivals the raucous opening of Igor Stravinsky's ballet, *The Rite of Spring* in Paris. The show became an important event in the history of American art, introducing astonished Americans, who were accustomed to realistic art, to the experimental styles of the European vanguard, including *Fauvism*, *Cubism*, and *Futurism*. The show served as a catalyst for American artists, who became more independent and created their own "artistic language." The Amory Show directly influenced the establishment of the **New York Museum of Modern Art**. After the Amory show we will be having lunch at Scaletta Restaurant where we will be spoiled by the delicious Northern Italian food served in a very welcoming setting. **The cost of this event is \$70 per person for Village residents and \$85 per person for non residents and it includes the bus, docent tour of the Armory show, lunch and all gratuities. The bus will leave promptly at 8AM from the Village Hall.**


