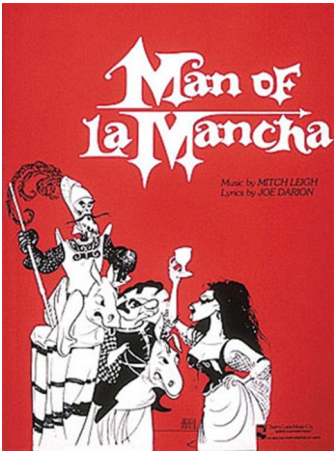
EAST HILLS WELCOMED A PRESENTATION BY JOURNALIST BILL PRESS

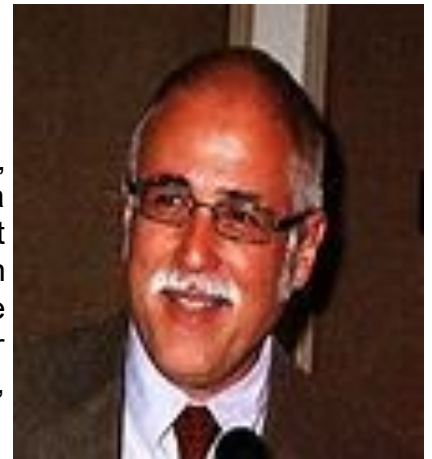
AN EVENING WITH “HAMILTON” THE MUSICAL

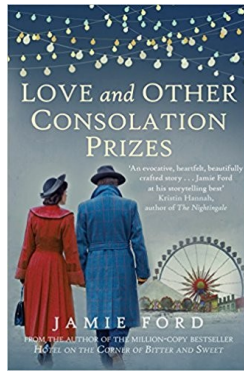

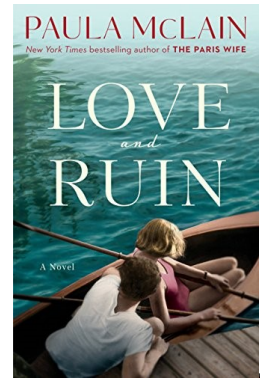
