The Village's Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control program will provide equivalent protection to the NYSDEC SPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activity. This includes reviewing SWPPPs submitted to the Village for projects disturbing an acre or greater of land. The review process will take note of any potential discharge of pathogens to the Hempstead Harbor watershed.

B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

The acre threshold for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activity is rarely met within the Village. There were ___ SWPPPs submitted to the Village in this reporting period. All construction projects are inspected an average of 3-4 times throughout the entire project regardless of size of disturbance. Security and Code Enforcement patrol the Village and respond to complaints on a daily basis.

The Village's Post-Construction Stormwater Management program will address stormwater runoff from regulated new development and redevelopment projects to the Village's MS4. All construction permit applications requiring changes in grades or impervious surfaces (regardless of size of land disturbance) are required to submit plans showing the grading and drainage of all surfaces, all septic and structures (existing and proposed), and the location, with details, of erosion control practices.

B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

The acre threshold for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activity is rarely met within the Village. All construction projects are required to use stormwater best management practices and are monitored for potential stormwater runoff conditions regardless of the size of land disturbance. The Village requires on-site retention facilities of new construction of impervious surfaces greater than 2,000 square feet.
