



The following is a list of some of the requirements that you should be aware of in planning for the location and installation of your fence:

## **Zoning Information:**

- o In residence districts, fences of any kind or description shall not exceed a height of 4' from ground level.
- o No fences are permitted to be erected within the front yard
- o All fences shall be so erected that the finished surface shall be faced outward.
- o No fence over 3' in height shall be erected unless the Building Inspector shall issue a permit therefor.
- o The enclosure of less than the entire rear yard of a lot, where such enclosed portion is used or intended to be used as a dog run or an enclosure for an animal or animals, and regardless of the height of such enclosure, shall not be permitted unless an application for a special permit therefor shall first have been made to the Board of Appeals.
- o Fences up to a maximum height of 6' from ground level shall be permitted <u>only</u> where the rear yard or side yard immediately abuts one of the following public streets, zoning districts or uses: Harbor Hill Road, Old Westbury Road, Roslyn Road, Business A District, Business B District, schools, recharge basins or the Park at East Hills.
- o Fences up to a maximum of 8' from ground level shall be permitted only where the rear yard or side yard immediately abuts one of the following public streets, zoning districts or uses: Glen Cove Road, Northern Boulevard, Light Industrial District.

## Sample drawings for fence location on a typical lot and typical corner lot:






Sample drawing for a proposed fence location on a property survey (corner lot):
